Drop off: 12pm-1pm / Pickup: 4pm -4:30pm

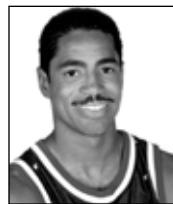
**Note to parents:** please be on time to drop off and pick up your camper each day. No one will be at the facility before 8am or after 4:30pm each day.
